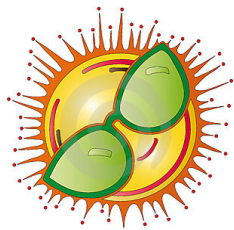

FAQ

Q. Do i need to issue new Terms of Engagement every time a worker changes assignment?

A. Terms of Engagement for temporary workers only need to be issued and signed once unless there is a legislation change. However, you do need to provide in writing to the worker details of the assignment each time an assignment changes.

Q. What is the difference between an Employment Business and an Employment Agency?

A. The difference between an employment business and an employment agency In basic terms is; an employment agency introduce permanent candidates to clients (who will pay the candidates directly); and an employment business supplies temporary workers to clients (who the employment business pay).

Q. Can agreeable workers still work over 48 hours once signing a waiver form?

A. The UK has retained the 48 hour opt out for the time being - this means that workers can agree to work more than 48 hours per week,

Q. If an agency is having to provide transport for a contract, can they charge the worker to cover the costs of the transport, and do they

INTERESTING STATISTICS FROM THE REC

- Industry turnover is now at a record level of £27.006 billion, a 1.3% increase on £26.673 billion last year.
- A total of 1.220,310 temporary workers were placed on an average week on a firm's payroll compared to 1.377,740 in 2006/2007.
- Overall turnover for temporary staff decreased 1.8% from £23.158 billion to £22.730 billion.
- Permanent placements decreased from 787,280 to 2006/07 to 726,280 in 2007/08
- Total turnover for permanent staff rose significantly by 21.7% from £3.514 billion to £4.276 billion.
- The temporary share of the total business was 84.2% and permanent 15.8% - up 1.6% on the previous year.
- The largest number of temporary placements was in the industrial and blue collar sector (18%) followed by construction at 14% and education/ teaching at 11%
- The largest number of permanent placements was in the nursing/ medical care sector with 15% followed by secretarial/ Clerical at 14% and technical/ engineering at 11%.
- Staff employed by the recruitment industry rose from 101,286 to 108,883, an increase of 7.5%

deduction is to bring the worker's pay below the national minimum wage. If the deduction does not bring the individual's pay below the NMW, then the deduction can be made. Please note that any deductions made are only legal if you have received consent from the worker.

Q. We want to supply staff to the food industry. If we apply for a gangmaster's license on line, can we supply the workers during the application process, or will we actually have to have had a licence before we supply?

A. The GLA require you to actually have the licence in hand before you are able to supply in the relevant sectors they cover.
